

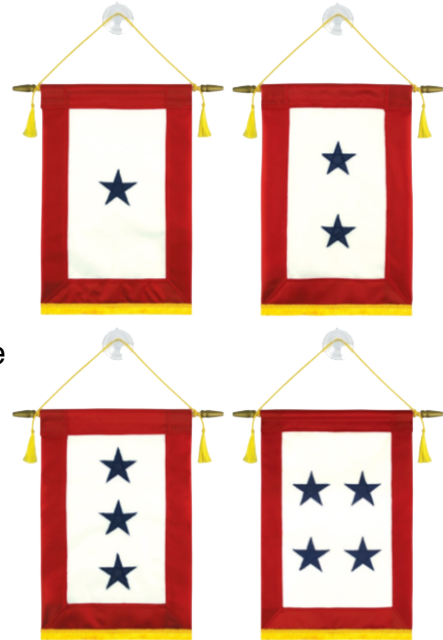
The Blue Star Flag
