John Joseph Dugan, Sr., 86, of Brazil, IN, died December 31, 2003.

Mr. Dugan started his career in the food industry while in high school beginning work with Kroger's Grocery. He moved to Brazil in 1952 and went to work at Chesty Potato Chips. Mr. Dugan started his own food brokerage company, Dugan - Doss Brokerage in Indianapolis which became one of the largest food brokerage companies in the Midwest.

A graduate of Cathedral High School, he entered the U.S. Army in 1941 and served until 1946 serving as Company Commander with the 96th Infantry Division in the Pacific participating in operations in the Philippines and invasion of Okinawa.
