Arthur Rudolph Geiss, 92, of Ottawa, KS passed away on January 28, 2015 at Wellsville Retirement Community. Arthur was born June 8, 1922 in Hiawatha, KS, the son of John Phillip Geiss and Birdie Cynthia (Shober) Geiss. Arthur graduated from Appanoose High School with the class of 1940.
